With all these accreditations our "Alligator Artist" is hard working, humble and very talented.



#### **JWS SPRING SHOW**

Receiving will be on Saturday, March 19 from 10am –4pm and Monday, March 21, 10am-2pm at a soon to be announced location on Atlantic Blvd. at the beach. #### Ted Nuttall workshop March 23,24,25.

Due to unusual circumstances we had several cancellations for the Ted Nuttall workshop and can take 5 people. If you like to work in transparent watercolor, in a traditional, but looser style, this should be very good. Ted would like each person to have a drawing of a portrait with or without partial figure, or have a full figure drawing already on the watercolor paper. He suggests you make a color copy and black and white copy of the person, (do not copy from magazines or other copywriter work). It should be the same size you will be working in . You may use a quarter sheet or half sheet. He thinks a whole sheet would be too difficult if you are not used to doing portraits. You may transfer the photo by holding it up to a window and tracing the figure or face, etc. or you may grid off the photo and grid your drawing paper and draw it on that way or you may project it from a projector if you have a slide and projector. Another way is to go over the back of the drawing with graphite (pencil) and then lay it on you paper and draw over the photo to make graphite lines on your watercolor paper. Bet some of you learned something just from reading this notice. You do not have to have experience in portrait painting. Try to have two drawings at least, maybe three if you paint fast. He will only be teaching the painting, not the drawing part. Do not put background in the drawing as it will be loosely rendered shapes. He will show us how to do all this. I have the list of paint colors, mostly what we already have. 140 lb or heavier watercolor paper is best. I use Arches myself. Also, med and large round pointed brushes are best for his technique. I look forward to hearing from some of you. **Joan** Dorrill at 904-471-3439. The cost is \$350.00 for members and that

includes lunch. The drawings do not have to be people you know, maybe better if you do not know them.


